

Pussy Willow


I have a little pussy






Bingo




Cupcakes

(Continue down to one little cupcake)




Once upon a time

It turned into a bear


Once upon a time

Bears in the Bed


Five bears in the bed, and the little one said,

I am a pizza, please take me home, Oh!




I am pizza (echo), peppers on top (echo)

There's a wee little man, in a wee little house Over the hill you see And he works all day and he works all night Making shoes for you and me



ie., high/low, loud/soft, silent, etc.)






Mary at the Cottage Door (a chant)

1, 2, 3, 4, Mary at the cottage door 5, 6, 7, 8, Eating cherries from a plate


(Play with the rhyme, ie; do the numerals softly, the words loudly, add different movements to the numerals and clap on the words. How many different ideas can you think of?)






Six Little Snowmen
